If you have any questions about the oil business, Midland has the Petroleum Museum. We are going to have a guide who has drilled and restored many wells in the Permian Basin. In addition to the Petroleum Museum, Midland is home to the Museum of the Southwest which includes a planetarium with a Dome Show, and the original boyhood home of George W. Bush. We are planning to attend a minor league baseball game between the Midland Rockhounds and the Corpus Christi Hooks.

Big Spring is about 40 miles to the east off of the I-20 freeway. Big Spring used to have the Webb Air Force Base. This was a training base used during the later part of WW-2 and Korea. After the base closed, the town folks opened the Hanger 25 Museum. The museum has a display of many of the airplanes which were used at the base. There is also a Vietnam Memorial in Big Spring which we plan to visit.

Odessa is the Rabbit Town of the area. There are 31 painted jackrabbits scattered around the city. The city also has a replica of Stonehenge on the campus of the University of Texas Permian Basin, and the Presidential Archives and Leadership Library which features the George H. Bush family home.


## WELCOME TO THE SPRINGS!

# Welcome to Colorado Springs - the Home of the U.S. Air Force Academy

The "Springs" is located at the eastern foot of the Rocky Mountains. It lies near glacier-carved <u>Pikes Peak</u>, a national landmark featuring a cog railway leading to its 14,115-foot summit. The city's <u>Garden of the Gods</u> Park features iconic red-sandstone formations and mountain views. It is also home to venerable Air Force Academy. Come and join us for what is sure to be a terrific time in *The Springs!* 

# HOTEL INFORMATION

We will be staying at the newly renovated, **Embassy Suites** Hotel located at 7290 Commerce Center Drive, Colorado Springs, CO 80919. The hotel room rate is just **\$155** plus tax per night. The room rate includes a hot breakfast buffet, served daily and 2 free drinks nightly, during reunion dates.



For those of you who choose to arrive early or stay late, the same room rate is available three days prior and three days after, based on availability. Make your hotel reservations NOW to insure the best availability. You may cancel without penalty up to 72 hours in advance.

The most reliable way to make hotel reservations is to click here. Enter your travel dates and follow the prompts. Or you may try and reach or message Veronica, the Reservation Manager, directly at the hotel (Mon-Fri only, from 9-4 MST). Call Veronica at (719)-599-9100. Request the USS Hornet

/Constellation group rate of \$155/night. If not busy the front desk may also be able to help. All rooms are Suites. Mountain View rooms are an extra \$40 more per night. Reservations are due by July 23.

Note: a limited number of 2 bedded suites available. If you need one, book now! If you have any problems getting a room at the group rate, especially if you are coming in early or staying late, please call Military Reunion Planners (MRP) at 817-251-3551. We can resolve *most* hotel issues.

## AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION & PARKING

Colorado Springs (COS) is the closest to the hotel. IF you are renting a car, consider flying into Denver as it's often cheaper and only about an hour away. You will need to make arrangements for a ride to the hotel, from either airport, as there is no shuttle. Uber is probably your best bet.

For those who are driving, the hotel offers plenty of free parking. If you need specific directions call the hotel's front desk (719) 599-9100 for assistance or click here.

#### UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY

Thursday, August 22 (9:30am-1:30pm)

Set in a scenic region at the foot of the Rocky Mountains and situated at an altitude of 7,163-feet, stands the youngest of the four service academies. Among the features are a Scenic Overlook of the campus, a B-52 Bomber, a Visitor Center with a movie that shows the first year of a cadet, including a huge gift shop and exhibit area. Your local guide will bring the past, present and future into focus as you enjoy a mostly riding tour of the campus. Note: the Chapel is under renovation but there is still lots to see.

The National Museum of World War II Aviation is world class. This museum has a new layout with several individual sections that covers different conflicts and the planes that served them.
